Three EURCAWs met National Reference Centers and Supporting Bodies

On **September, 13th** the **three EURCAWs** (EURCAW Ruminants & Equines, EURCAW Pigs, and EURCAW Poultry-SFA) hosted the second workshop with National Reference Centres for Animal Welfare and the Competent Authorities' Supporting Bodies.

In total **89 participants** from **22 Member States** participated, including 24 members from the three EURCAWs, and three delegates from DG SANTE of the European Commission.

The aims of the meeting were to increase collaboration, facilitate knowledge exchange, and to get input to the next work programmes for the three EURCAWs.

2022 Highlights

Third meeting with Competent Authorities

The **third EU-network meeting** between representatives of EU MS Competent Authorities (CAs) and the EURCAW-Poultry-SFA, took place in Palma (Spain) on **September, 28-29**, **2022** on 1,5 days.

In total **59 participants**, from **19 EU MSs** participated, including **26 delegates from CAs**, and 14 from EURCAW-Poultry-SFA. One EFTA representatives attended as observer.

This meeting was the occasion to present the objectives of the Centre, and the Centre's work performed since last meeting. Furthermore, it permitted to discuss potential future priority areas of work, identify possible collaboration at the national level, and identify the main needs and expectations of CAs.








Second Reflection Board meeting

In total **12 participants, seven** of them from seven EU platform entities forming the **RB**, four from EURCAW-Poultry-SFA were connected. One representative from DG SANTE attended as an observer.

Inter-Observer Repeatability of Indicators of





This summer, the Centre was celebrating the publication of its second scientific paper as a result of the work carried out in <u>Activity 3 in</u> <u>2020 and 2021</u>. This study aimed at investigating the pertinence of different animal-based indicators for the assessment of broiler's state of consciousness after waterbath stunning before and during bleeding. This article named "Inter-Observer Repeatability of Indicators of Consciousness after Waterbath Stunning in Broiler Chickens" is available <u>here</u>.

This <u>study</u> is aimed at investigating the pertinence of different animal-based indicators (ABIs) for the assessment of broiler's state of consciousness after waterbath stunning (WBS) before and during bleeding.


Welfare Quality Network

On **Thursday, October, 27th 2022** the <u>Welfare Quality Network</u> held its annual seminar on animal welfare indicators. This year the meeting was jointly organized by the three EURCAWs and held in Wageningen, The Netherlands.

The target audience consisted of scientific institutes who act as support bodies to their governments on animal welfare issues. In addition, the meeting was attended by representatives from the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), the Dutch Competent Authority (NVWA), and industry aiming to improve welfare assessment through quality schemes. Around **40 people** were physically present and **30** attended on-line.

Twelve speakers addressed the most recent developments in practical application of animal-based measures. The day started with presentations about animal welfare in the Netherlands and trademarks developed to assess animal welfare in Europe. In the second half of the morning, presentations were given about manual Welfare Quality assessments. The afternoon focused on research into the use of sensors for Welfare Quality assessments. For example, the use of camera's, RFID, and other non-invasive sensor technologies.


Alexandra Contreras-Jodar had the opportunity to present the Centre's work on Relevant indicators of consciousness in broiler chicken after waterbath stunning.




